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# Pablo Díaz Carballo


Pablo Díaz is a renowned international contemporary artist born in Venezuela and now living in the USA due to a self-imposed exile forced by the persecution and harassment from the socialist regime.

Pablo Diaz's style has been inspired by San Francis of Assisi and artists like Giotto di Bondone, Rembrandt, Duchamp, Andy Warhol, J. Beuys and Joseph Kosuth.

Pablo has focused his work on a concept that he calls "The House of the Inner Being" which explores on the state of our intangible interior house or body and is reflected physically in the form of a structure.



This painting reflects the inner state of a person that is looking for the answer of a problem, feels confussion in the darkness, but thinking and looking for the light of the answers and keeps thinking how to find the exit and resolve the problem.



This painting reflects the inner state of a person who was able to get out of the problem and is at peace, he is out of the darkness and confusion and is living an orderly life until the next challenge.

Pablo started working with children using his Conceptual Art and Music techniques, and built an art and music programs that was designed to bring awareness and promote the children's artistic talents.

The socialist regime in Venezuela, decided that Pablo's teachings were not in line with the socialist agenda, and in 2014, Pablo's home was stormed by the government's collective militia and he and his family were held captive, interrogated and mentally tortured for several hours, their lives were also threatened.

Late 2014, Pablo and his family were forced to go into self-exile in the Lesser Antilles Island of Willemstad, which is part of the Netherlands Kingdom in the Caribbean Sea. There they taught the art program in public and private schools and closed with an art exhibition in the National Library.

Pablo also wrote a book that compiles the ideas that forced him into exile, and had an interview with a journalist living in the USA.

In December of 2019 the USA granted asylum to Pablo and his family, the struggle was over! He created 33 paintings to celebrate his new home and his freedom and they are available for purchase at this Catalogue.

# The importance of conceptual art



# Diversity of results







Pablo Díaz paints what he sees, but each image poses a new challenge. With each action of the brush, the artist faces a new problem, because the spontaneous image always seeks to return to chaos. It is in this struggle that the artist tries to dominate the image while establishing order, composition, balance, harmony, color and beauty.

Hence, we see such a variety of results, since according to this working methodology the artist does not force the image according to a premeditated style, but lets it flow and applies tension, as if he were taming a wild animal.

The painter takes advantage of this dynamic to create variations and improvisation on the same theme, such as in music. With each new stroke the image takes him from one challenge to the next until he decides to stop the process, when he knows that the work is ready.

This methodology is based on the theory of the Phenomenology of Perception by the philosopher Maurice Merleau Ponty, in his book the "Eye and the Spirit". "... when the painter traces the first brushstroke on a neutral plane, he activates various tensions that confront him ..."

# Collecting Works of Art

Collecting works of art is one of the safest ways to preserve capital investment, it is not easy to select a good work of contemporary art among so many available; the artist's career and his history must be taken into account as well as the contributions that he has made, in order to correctly assess the value of his work.

Pablo Díaz is an artist who through his work of art, social sciences, private banking and private enterprise, has introduced a change in the system of basic education of his country, Venezuela, through art and music programs has developed the creative skills of five thousand students.





Through Conceptual Art, and the concept of his painting, Pablo started working with children and was educating them about art and music creativity in school programs and this work lives on in the students who participated in this contemporary conceptual art movement.

The main value of Pablo Diaz Carballo's work is his concept and the approach to different themes through his style and using the values of the contemporary and conceptual art movement of the 20th and 21st centuries.



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

"My neighbors spend a lot of time taking care of the flowers in their garden.

Mrs. Moats is an artist in the process of planting and caring for various flowers to create a true work of art in the large garden of her house, which could be indirectly related to the artists of the Land Art movement.

In the spring Mrs. Moats had worked for weeks and had already finished all the work in the garden, but the weather in this state is unpredictable, suddenly an unexpected snowfall fell and in one night it ruined all the flowers.

At that moment I realized the metaphor between the beauty and fragility of flowers and the beauty and fragility of freedom.

Freedom is not free, to maintain those privileges, proactive citizens are needed in their communities, like gardeners, to maintain the system that gives us the privilege of living in freedom."






